Let's hope he comes back again sometime!

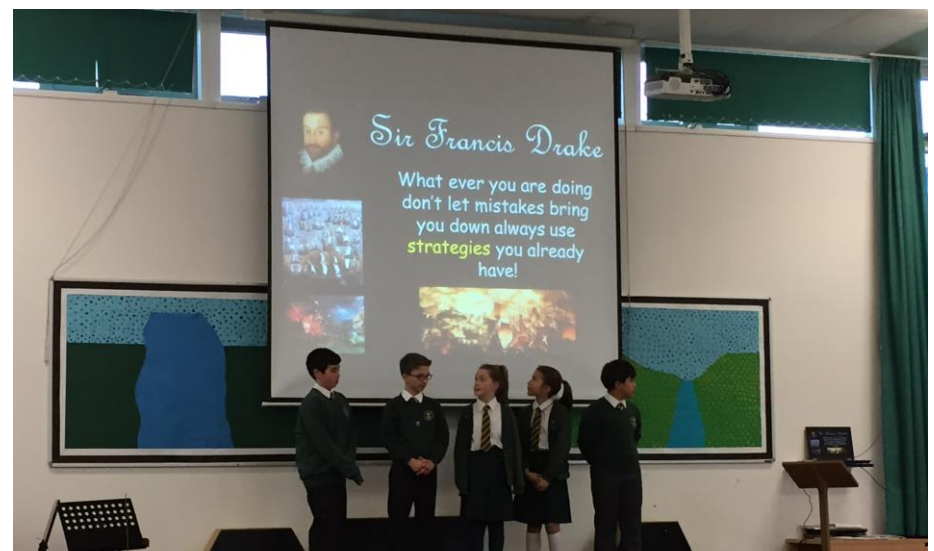
